January - Romans 12:2

Rom. 12:2 Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is — his good, pleasing and perfect will.

February - John 1:14

John 1:14 The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

March - John 2:11

John 2:11 This, the first of his miraculous signs, Jesus performed at Cana in Galilee. He thus revealed his glory, and his disciples put their faith in him.

April - John 3:21

John 3:21 But whoever lives by the truth comes into the light, so that it may be seen plainly that what he has done has been done through God."

May - John 5:24

June - John 6:35

July - John 7:38

John 7:38 Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, streams of living water will flow from within him."

August - 1 Kings 17:24

1Kings 17:24 Then the woman said to Elijah, "Now I know that you are a man of God and that the word of the LORD from your mouth is the truth."

September - John 8:58

John 8:58 "I tell you the truth," Jesus answered, "before Abraham was born, I am!"

October - John 9:39

John 9:39 Jesus said, "For judgment I have come into this world, so that the blind will see and those who see will become blind."

November - John 10:7-8

John 10:7 Therefore Jesus said again, "I tell you the truth, I am the gate for the sheep. 8 All who ever came before me were thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them.

December - Luke 2:30-32
