

June 26 & 27, 2018: The Plan to Stop Paul
Bible Passage: Acts 23

Main Point: When Paul was arrested, God protected him so he could preach about Jesus.

Key Passage: *I eagerly expect and hope that ... Christ will be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death. For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.* Philippians 1:20-21

Big Picture Question: When should we tell others about Jesus? We should always tell others about Jesus even when it is difficult.

Day 1: READ -> Acts 23:1-11

THINK -> How do you think Paul felt when he was arrested?

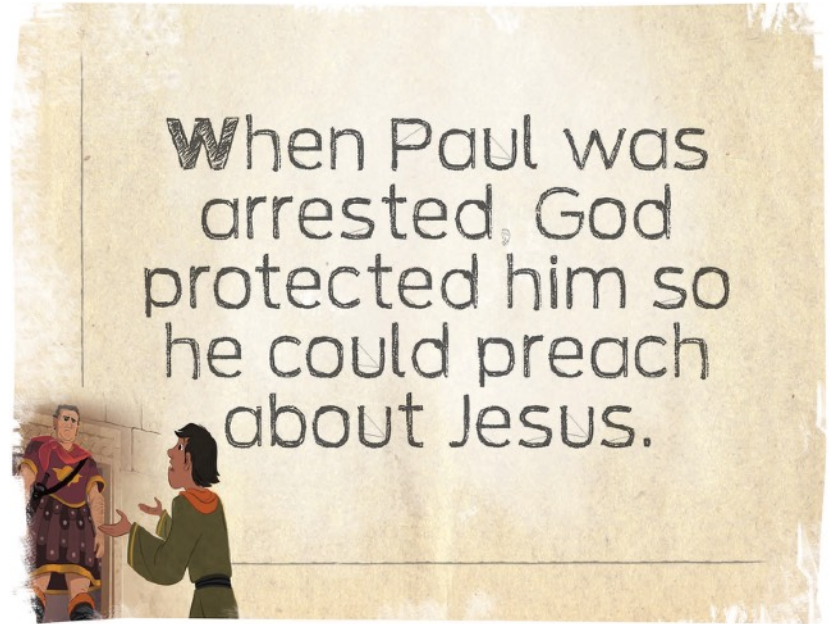

Day 2: READ -> Acts 23:12-22
