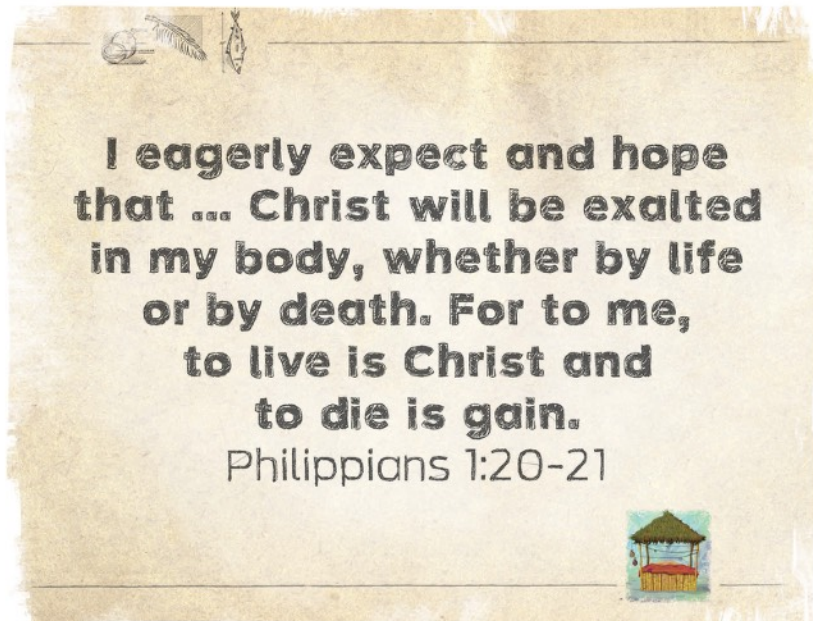

June 9 & 10, 2018: Paul Before Rulers
Bible Passage: Acts 24:22-27; 25:1-14; 26:24-32

Main Point: Paul preached about Jesus to governors and kings.

Key Passage: *I eagerly expect and hope that ... Christ will be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death. For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.* Philippians 1:20-21

Big Picture Question: When should we tell others about Jesus? We should always tell others about Jesus even when it is difficult.

Day 1: READ -> Acts 24:22-27

THINK -> Did Felix believe what Paul told him about Jesus? Is it worthwhile to talk about Jesus if the person doesn't believe?

PRAY -> God can use any circumstance for His good! Ask God to help you to be willing to tell others about Jesus no matter what happens.

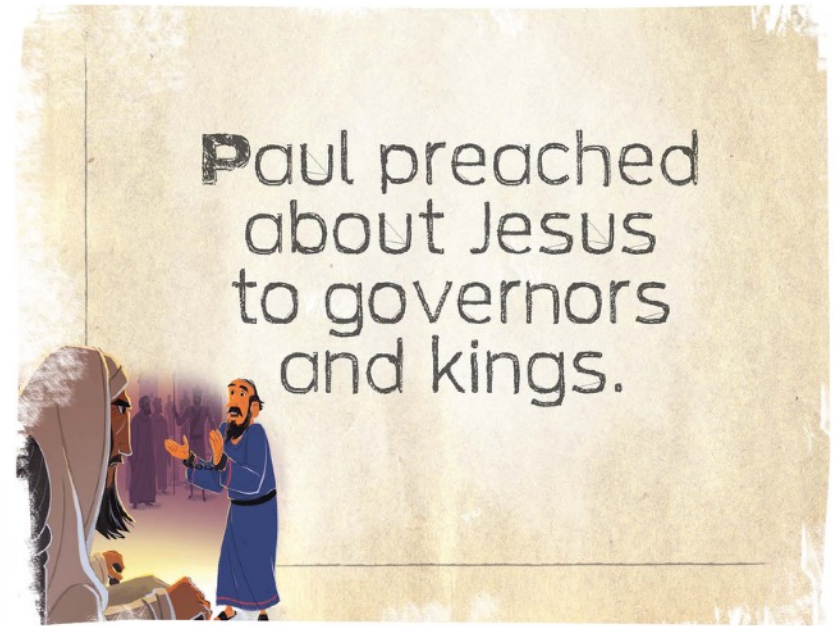

Day 2: READ -> Acts 25:1-14

THINK -> Was Paul afraid of the rulers?
Why do you think so?

PRAY -> Paul was willing to be bold and speak the truth before the leaders. If you haven't done anything wrong, then you have nothing to fear! Ask God to help you to not be afraid when troubles come.



Day 3: READ -> Acts 26:24-32

THINK -> What did Paul tell King Agrippa when he thought he was crazy? Did Paul get angry or frustrated?

PRAY -> God wants to use you, and will give you the words to say. People may not believe right away when you tell them about Jesus, but you should still be obedient in telling others about Him. Ask God to help you to be bold and to give you the words He wants you to share.
