June 30 & July 1, 2018: Paul Made Much of Jesus

Bible Passage: Colossians 1:15-2:3

Main Point: Jesus is better than anyone or anything else.

Key Passage: *I eagerly expect and hope that ... Christ will be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death. For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.* Philippians 1:20-21

Big Picture Question: When should we tell others about Jesus? We should always tell others about Jesus even when it is difficult.

Day 1: READ -> Colossians 1:15-23

THINK -> Focus on Colossians 1:15-20. Who does Paul say that Jesus is? Is Jesus really God?

PRAY -> Thank God that because of Christ's death on the cross, we can have peace. God brought all things back to Himself because of what Christ has done!

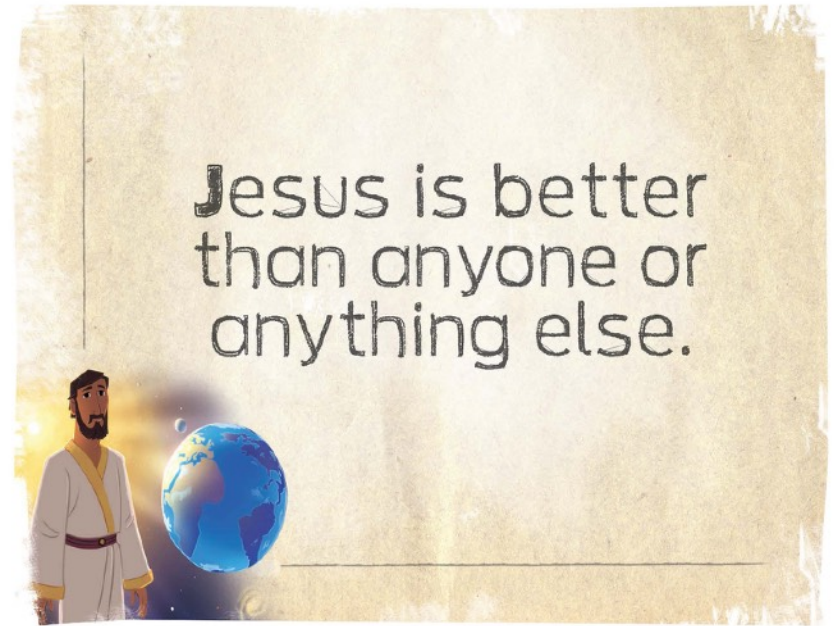

Day 3: **JOURNAL** -> Names for Jesus
