

Day 4: READ -> Exodus 12: 1-7, 12-14, 31-32

THINK -> God warned Egypt through Moses and to let His people go. Pharaoh would not listen. God had a plan to save His people. Passover was a special night because God set the Israelites free from slavery in Egypt. Passover is also one of God's big clues about the coming of Jesus. On Passover night, the firstborn sons of those who sacrificed a spotless lamb did not die. Thousands of years later, Jesus died on the cross as a perfect lamb as a sacrifice for our sins.

DO -> Hang a red ribbon somewhere in your house. Anyone who sees the red ribbon has to recite our memory verse below.

Once everyone in the house has recited the verse at least once, move the ribbon to a new place the next morning. Keep moving the ribbon and reciting the verse throughout the week.

PRAY -> Thank God for setting His people free from slavery and for setting us free from our sins through Jesus!

January 5 & 6, 2019: The Plagues and the Passover

Bible Passage: Exodus 5-12

Main Point: God delivered His people and proved that He is the one true God.

Key Passage: *I have been the LORD your God ever since you came out of Egypt. You shall acknowledge no God but me, no Savior except me.*

Hosea 13:4

Big Picture Question: Is there anything God cannot do? God can do all things according to His character.

Day 1: READ -> Exodus 5:1-9, 22-23

THINK & RESPOND -> Moses did what God said. When Moses obeyed God, the slaves had more trouble. How did this make Moses feel?

PRAY -> Thank God for for always being faithful. Sometimes things get worse before they get better. Ask God to help you continue to obey Him because He has wonderful plans for you!

Day 2: READ -> Exodus 6:1-5 & 7:1-6

PRAY -> Ask God to help you to obey His Word and not be stubborn. Allow God to soften your heart so that it doesn't become hard.
