THINK & DISCUSS-> The people really got worried. They could only think about being scared. Joshua and Caleb tore their clothes. In Old Testament times, this was a sign of great sadness. Joshua and Caleb were upset that the people were not focusing on the great things the Promised Land had for them. Later in the chapter, God tells Moses that only Caleb, Joshua and the children will be allowed into the Promised Land because they had faith.

Day 3: READ -> Numbers 13:28-33

READ & DISCUSS -> Most of the men were worried about the size and strength of the men and city in Canaan. They didn't believe the Israelites should try and take the land. BUT... Caleb did. He spoke up and said, "Let's Go!" The men reported their worry to the rest of the Israelites. They were scared by what they saw and they forgot God was with them.

Has this ever happened to you? What do you worry about? Talk about it as a family.
